PROUD HOPE broke the quickest, was allowed to settle just off the pace, came two wide around the turn, cut the corner turning for home and was closing the quickest but ran out of ground. MUD LIGHT rushed up to duel with the winner soon after the start, remained in contention to the head of the lane and flattened in the final furlong. ATASCADERAN chased the leaders from the start, raced three wide through the turn and could not make further headway. OLYMPIAN MEDAL did not reach contention. LORD ELIJAH could not keep up in a wide trip.

LA VIE'S TOPPER sprinted to the front soon after the start, set a pressured pace to the furlong pole and had nothing left for the drive.. BOY HOWDY dwelt at the start to lose all chance.
