THE CAT DID IT was always close, rallied three wide through the final turn, dueled gamely with the winner between rivals through the stretch and just missed. CINNAMON TEAL rushed into contention early, attended the pace, opened a short lead a furlong from home, dueled furiously to the final yards inside and flattened somewhat in the final strides. SECRET FIFTEEN sprinted to the fore soon after the start, set all the pace for a half mile, began to tire while saving ground through the final turn and had little left for the drive. LIL JILL raced in the middle of the pack throughout and had no rally. X X RATED showed little. WILD LUVIN broke outward, raced four wide though the final turn and did not rally. ON TOP OF THE MOON was never a factor. NICENCOZY was outrun.

UP THE CREEK raced in the middle of the pack, crept into contention after a half mile then came up empty. BAD GUY good speed to the final turn, was checked hard at mid turn and lost all momentum.
